AUTHORIZED DEPARTMENT STORE AGENCIES



It is the privilege of the Local Council to recommend to the National Business Committee, a local agency to sell uniforms and general equipment, not including buttons, badges, insignia and Girl Scout green cloth by the yard. The Council should appoint a uniform committee to instruct such agency in regard to restrictions on sale of equipment. This committee may recommend to the National Business Committee that an agency be discontinued and a new one appointed at any time. No agency will be appointed unless the dis-

trict has a quota of at least fifty registered Girl Scouts, and in no case will a second agency be appointed unless the district has at least 500 registered Girl Scouts. Equipment will not be shipped to any agency unless regularly appointed by the National Business Committee. All official equipment for department stores must be secured from the National Equipment Department at National Headquarters. Complete information will be furnished at any time by the National Equipment Department.
