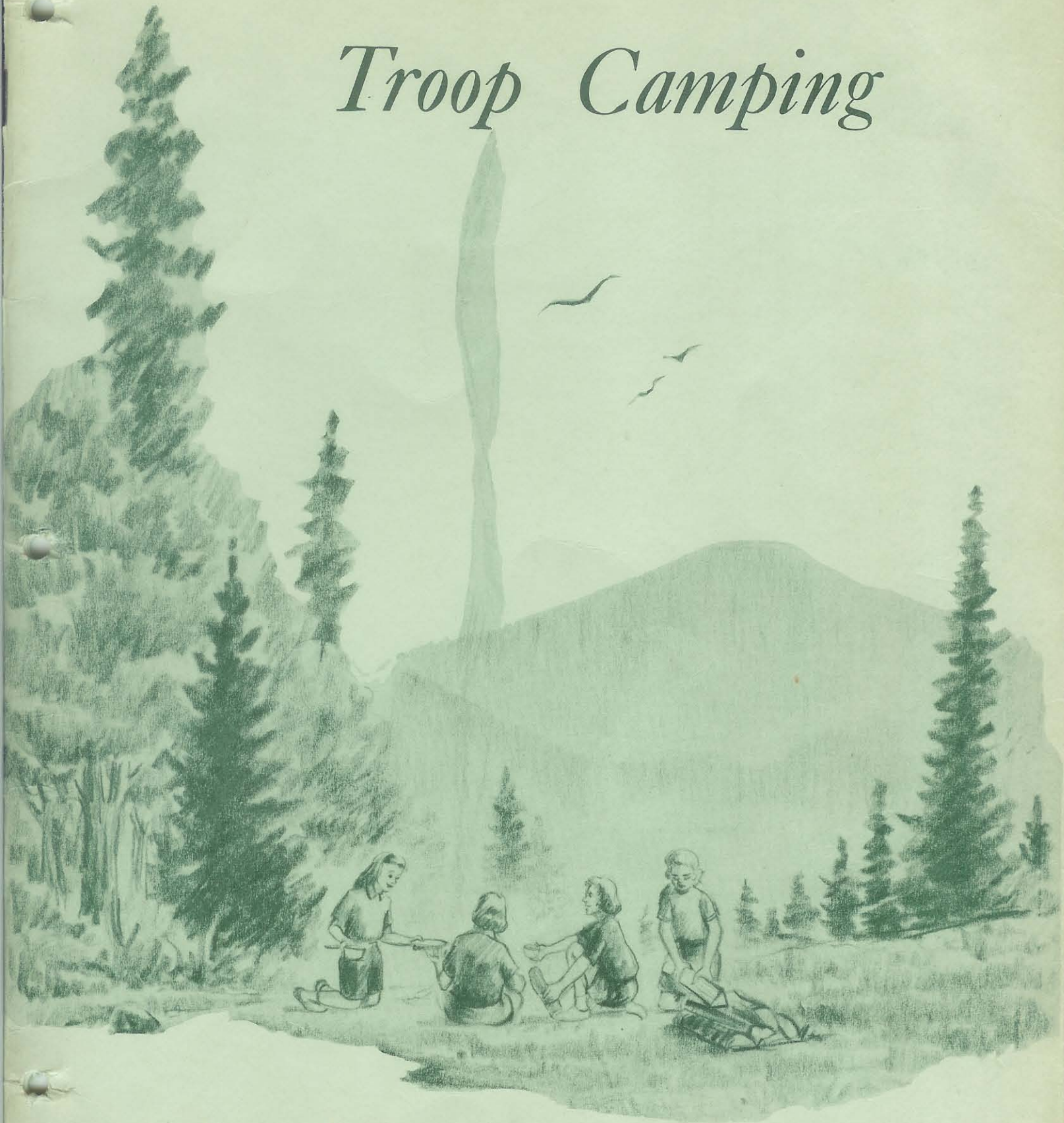


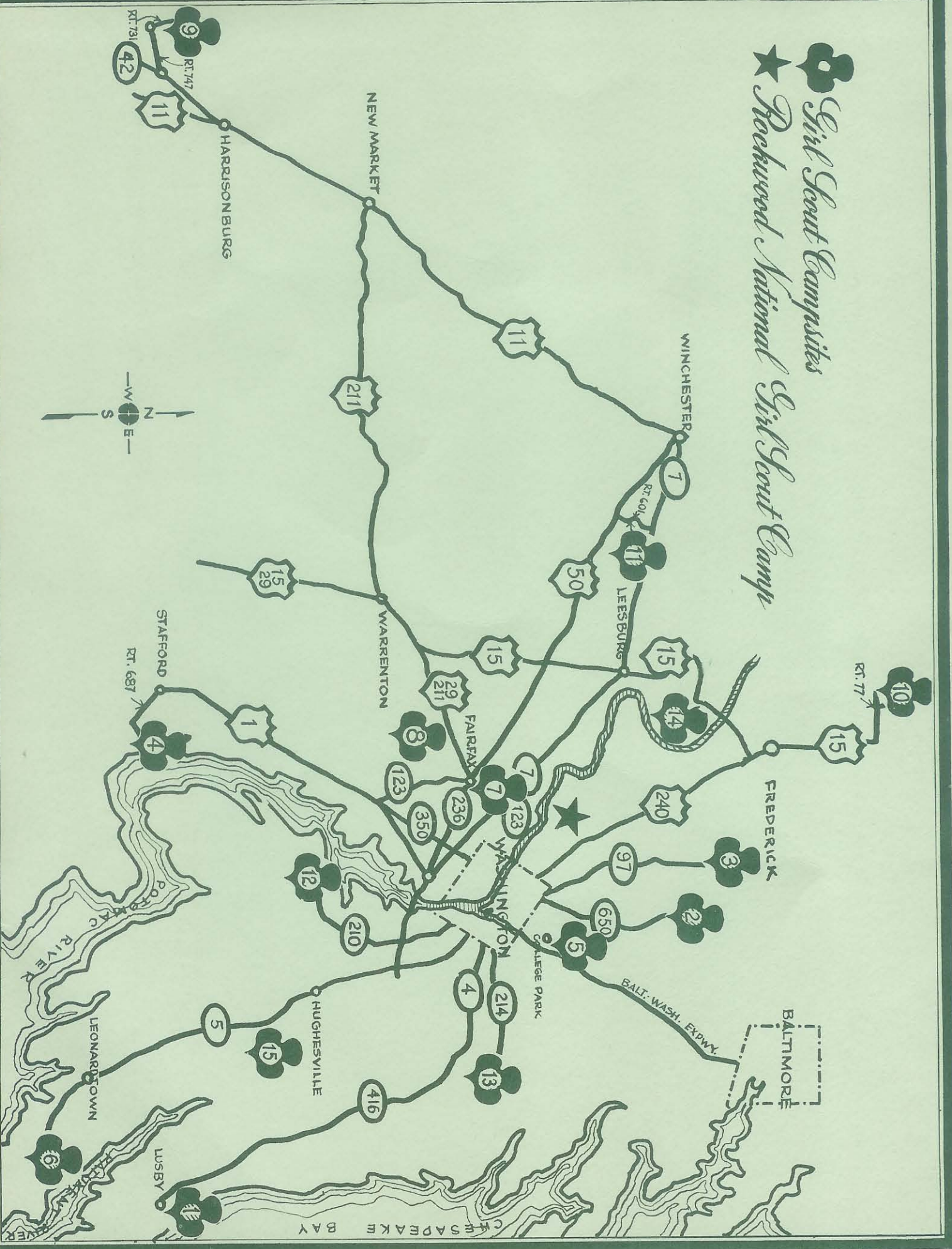

*Dear Leader*

The Girl Scout Council of the Nation's Capital welcomes you and your troop to Troop Camping in our great new council.

We have 15 campsites for your pleasure. Keep this booklet as your guide - it will help you make plans to see new places, try different camping techniques and facilities, explore varied terrains, and have real progression in your camping experiences.

Remember, troop camping is for everyone! It is done by one troop with its leaders. Together they plan and carry out their own camp for one night or longer, on sites provided or approved by your council. Herein are described all council-owned or leased troop camp sites. Other approved troop camp sites in Region III are listed.

Brownies will plan Brownie holidays in lodges and cabins; Intermediates - Juniors and Cadettes - will progress from lodges to adirondack shelters and platform tents, and then to primitive camping; Senior scouts will tackle them all.

Reservations for the entire year will be accepted after January 1st.

1. Leader requests tentative reservation by phoning or writing the Girl Scout Council of the Nation's Capital, 1815 N. Fort Myer Drive, Arlington 9, Virginia, listing first, second and third choice of site and time.
2. A reservations form will then be sent for the leader to fill out and return, with the required fees to confirm the reservation. The leader will also receive specific information and instructions for the use of the site reserved.

Fees for all equipped sites will be the same - \$6.50 for two nights or more, \$5.00 for one night, and will include the use of all available equipment.

Day visit or cook-out sites are available at most camps. No equipment is available at these, and no fee will be charged.

Be sure you have the required camp training - or sign up for a course now.

Put that "outing back in scouting", go have fun in the out-of-doors with your troop!

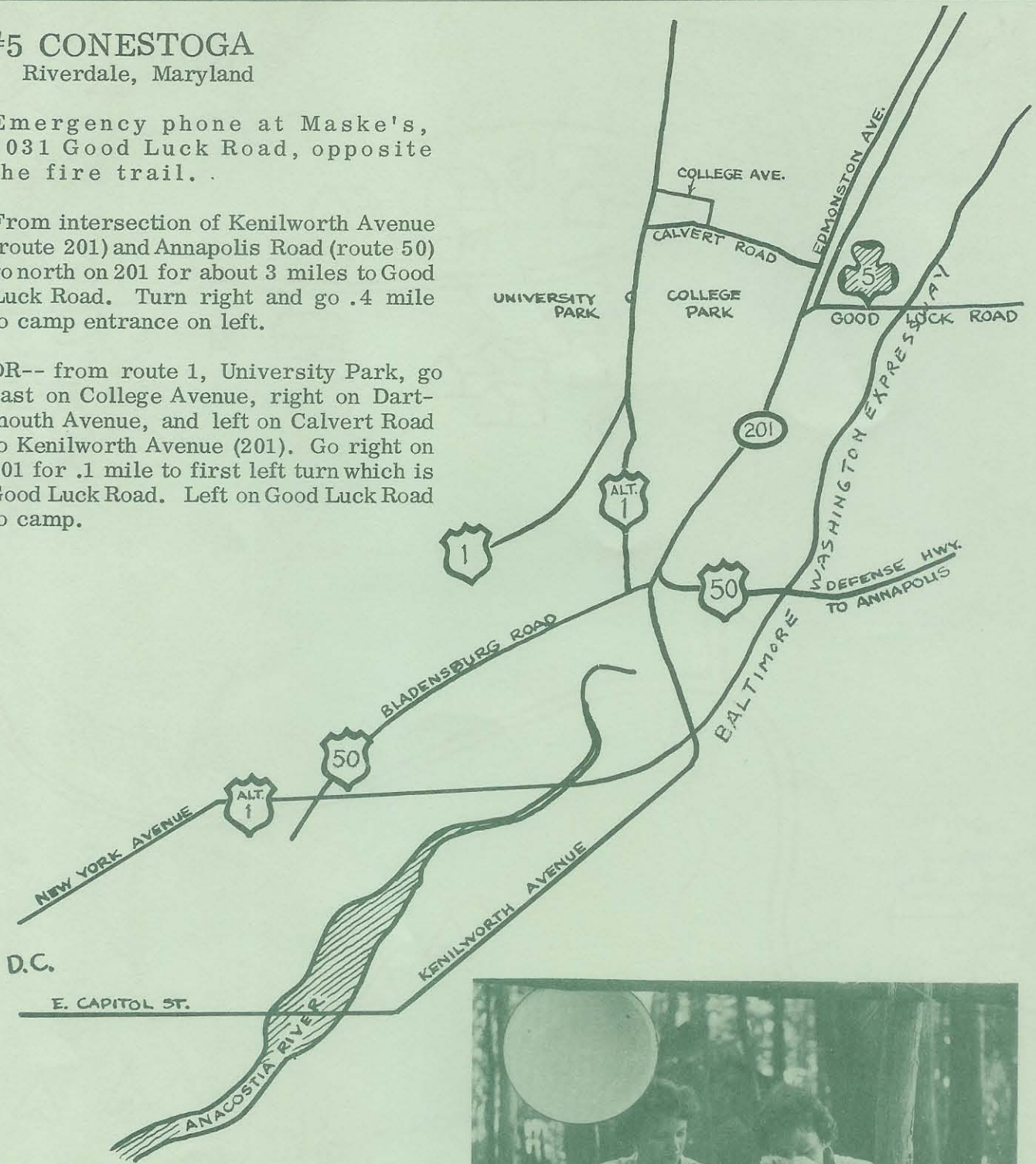
# #5 CONESTOGA

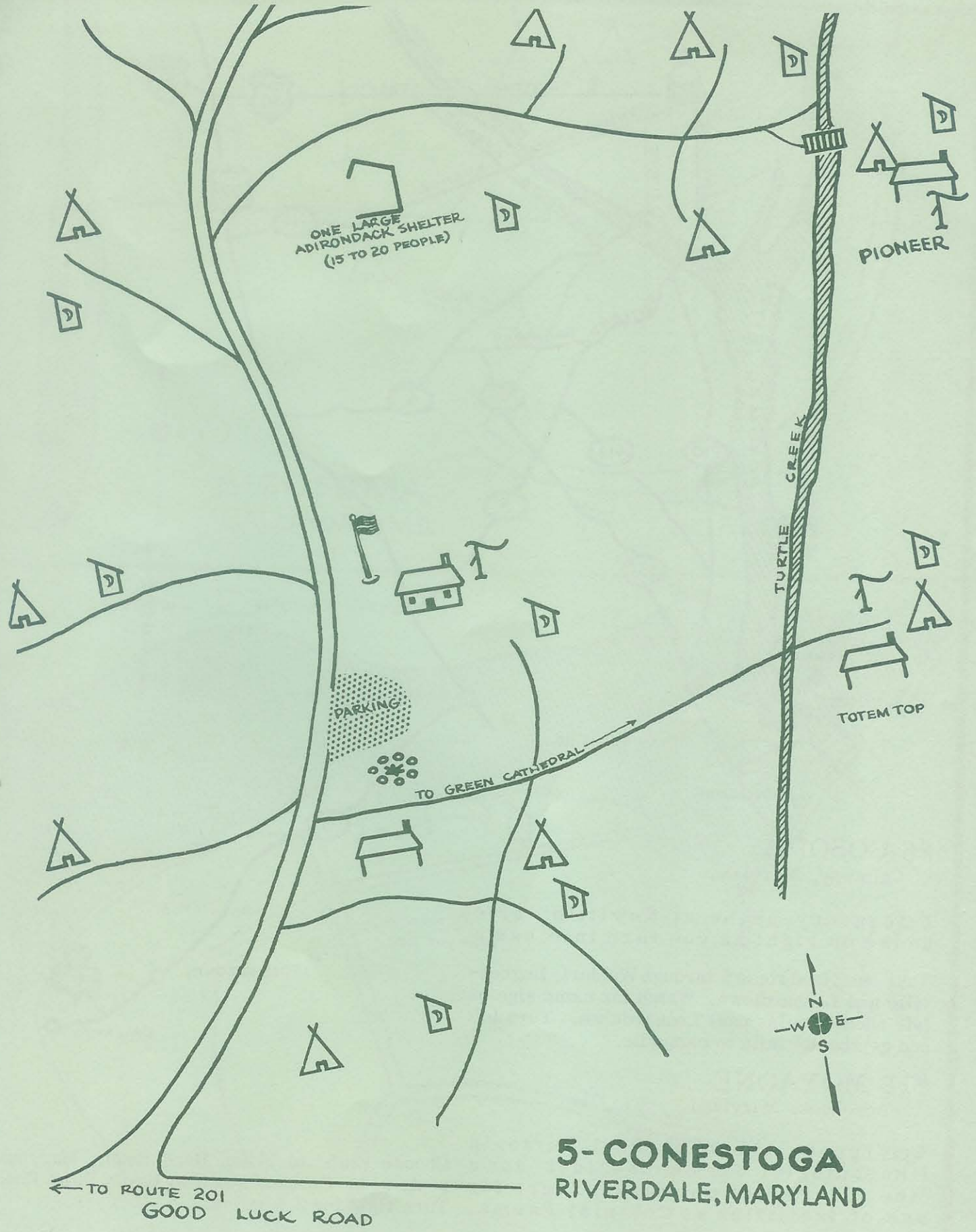

Emergency phone at Maske's, 6031 Good Luck Road, opposite the fire trail.

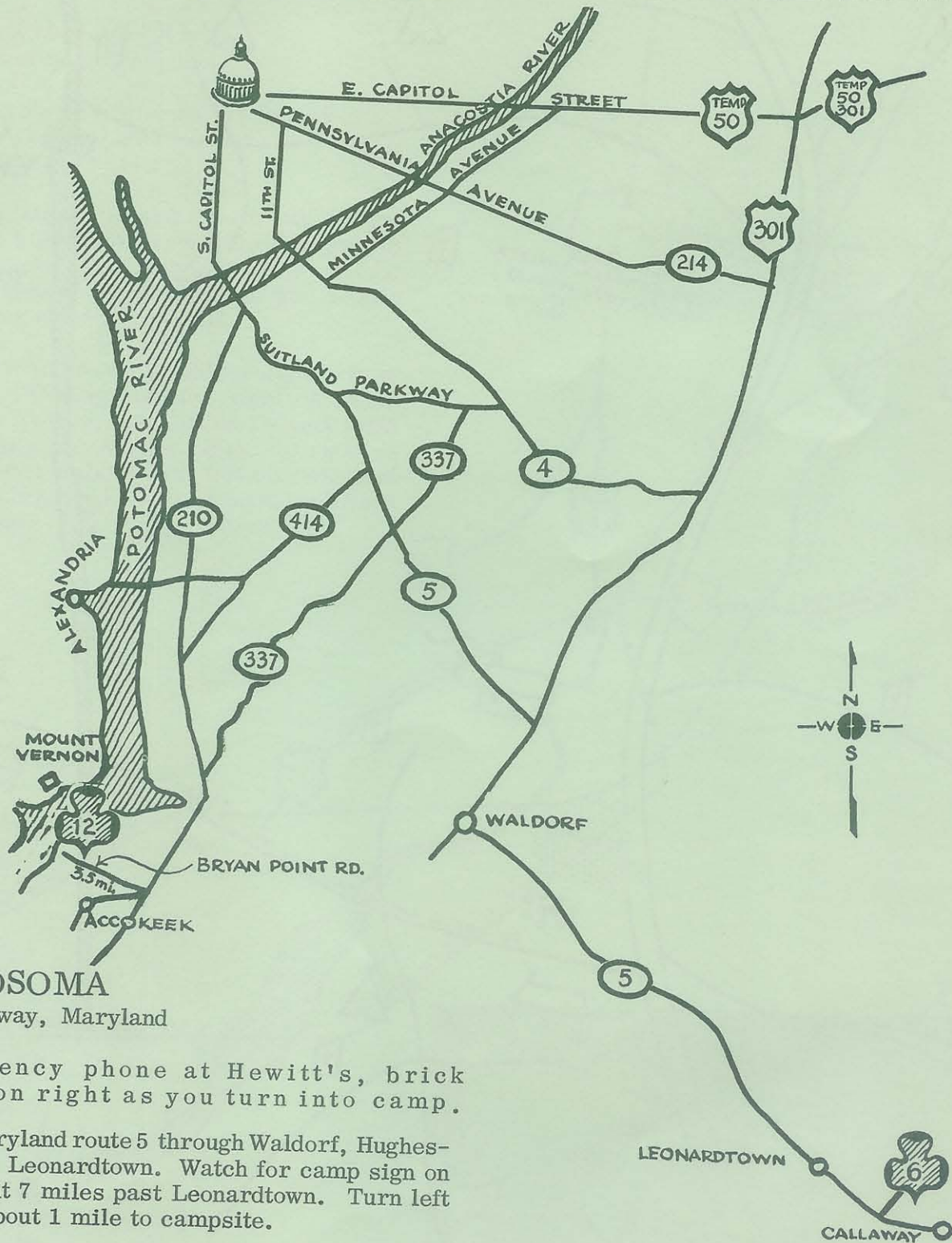
From intersection of Kenilworth Avenue (route 201) and Annapolis Road (route 50) go north on 201 for about 3 miles to Good Luck Road. Turn right and go .4 mile to camp entrance on left.

OR-- from route 1, University Park, go east on College Avenue, right on Dartmouth Avenue, and left on Calvert Road to Kenilworth Avenue (201). Go right on 201 for .1 mile to first left turn which is Good Luck Road. Left on Good Luck Road to camp.

Callaway, Maryland

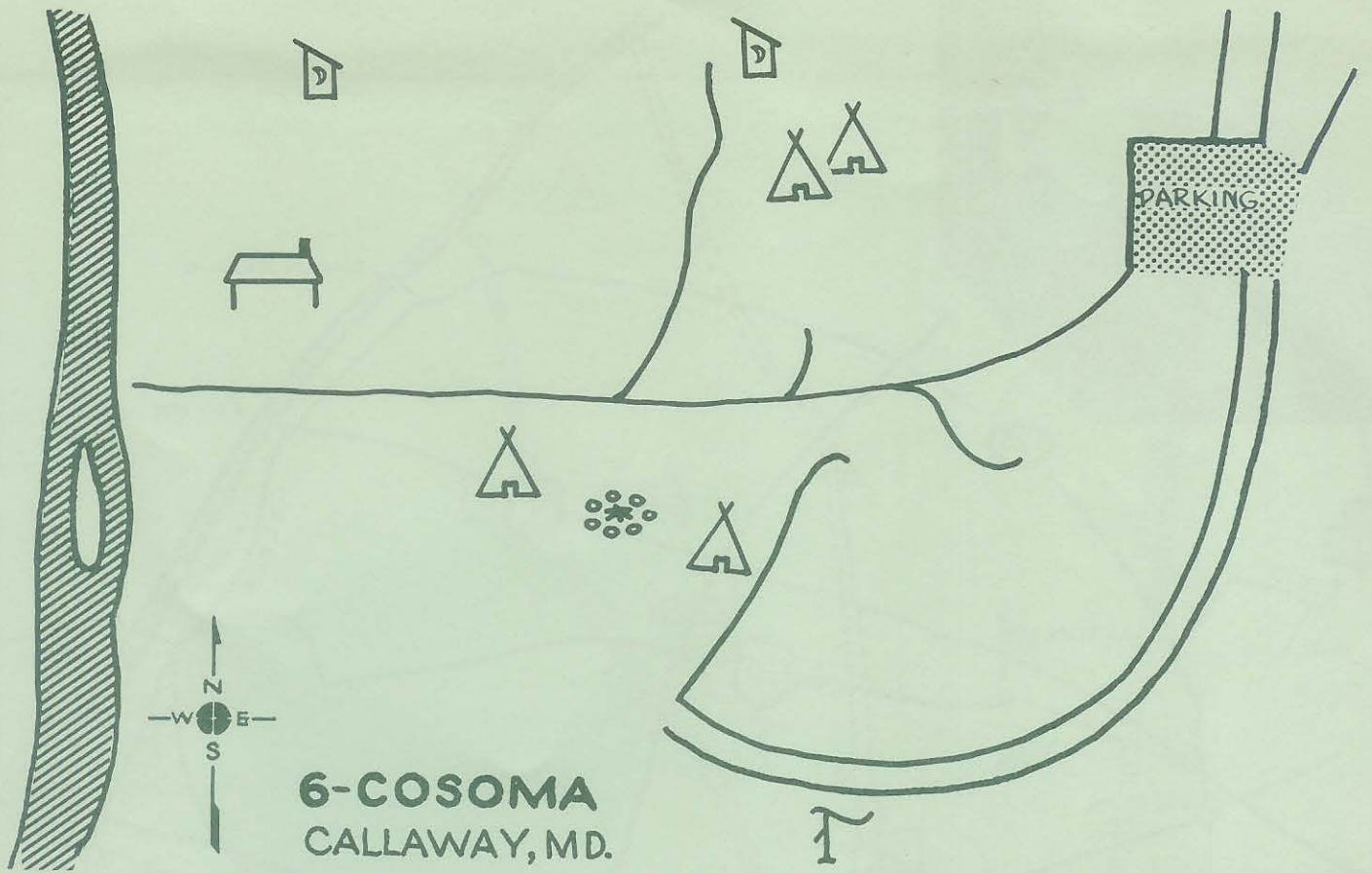
Emergency phone at Hewitt's, brick house on right as you turn into camp.

Take Maryland route 5 through Waldorf, Hughesville and Leonardtown. Watch for camp sign on left about 7 miles past Leonardtown. Turn left and go about 1 mile to campsite.

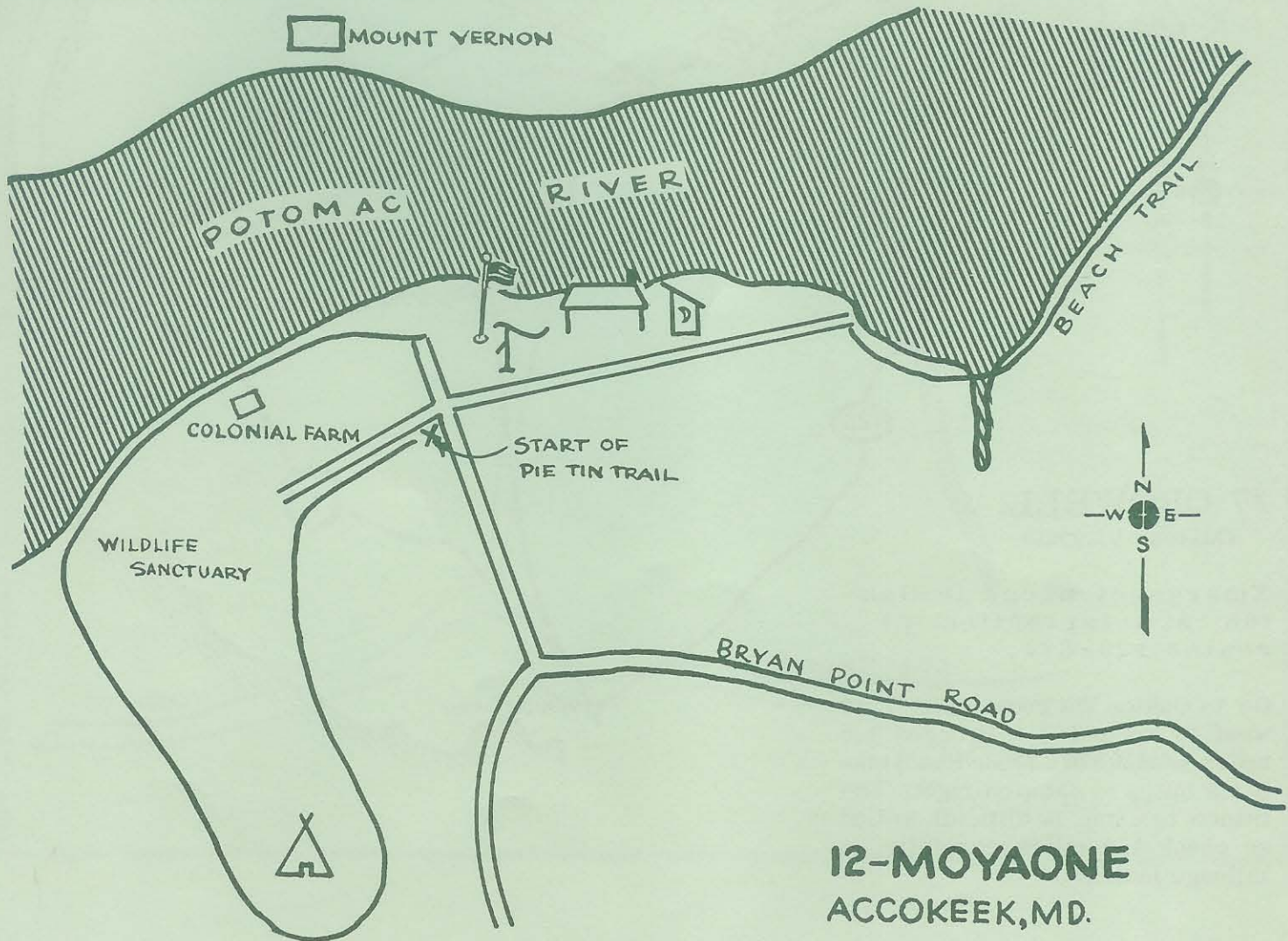
## #12 MOYAONE

Emergency phone at Paul Burton's (the colonial farmhouse just down the river) Get permission here for use of facilities at Colonial Farms. Choose route to Indian Head Road, Maryland route 210. Proceed south to Bryan Point Road. Turn right for 3.5 miles.

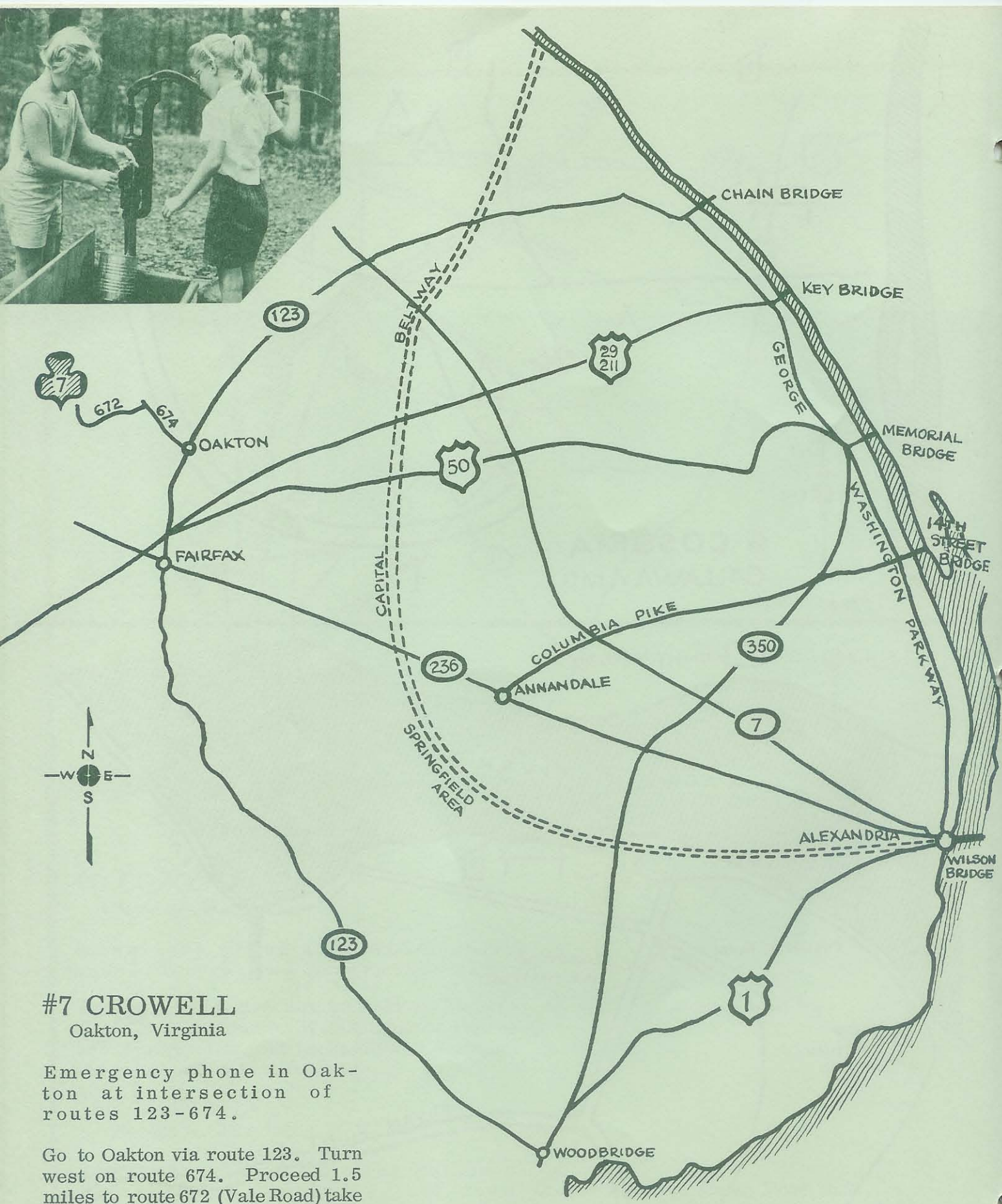

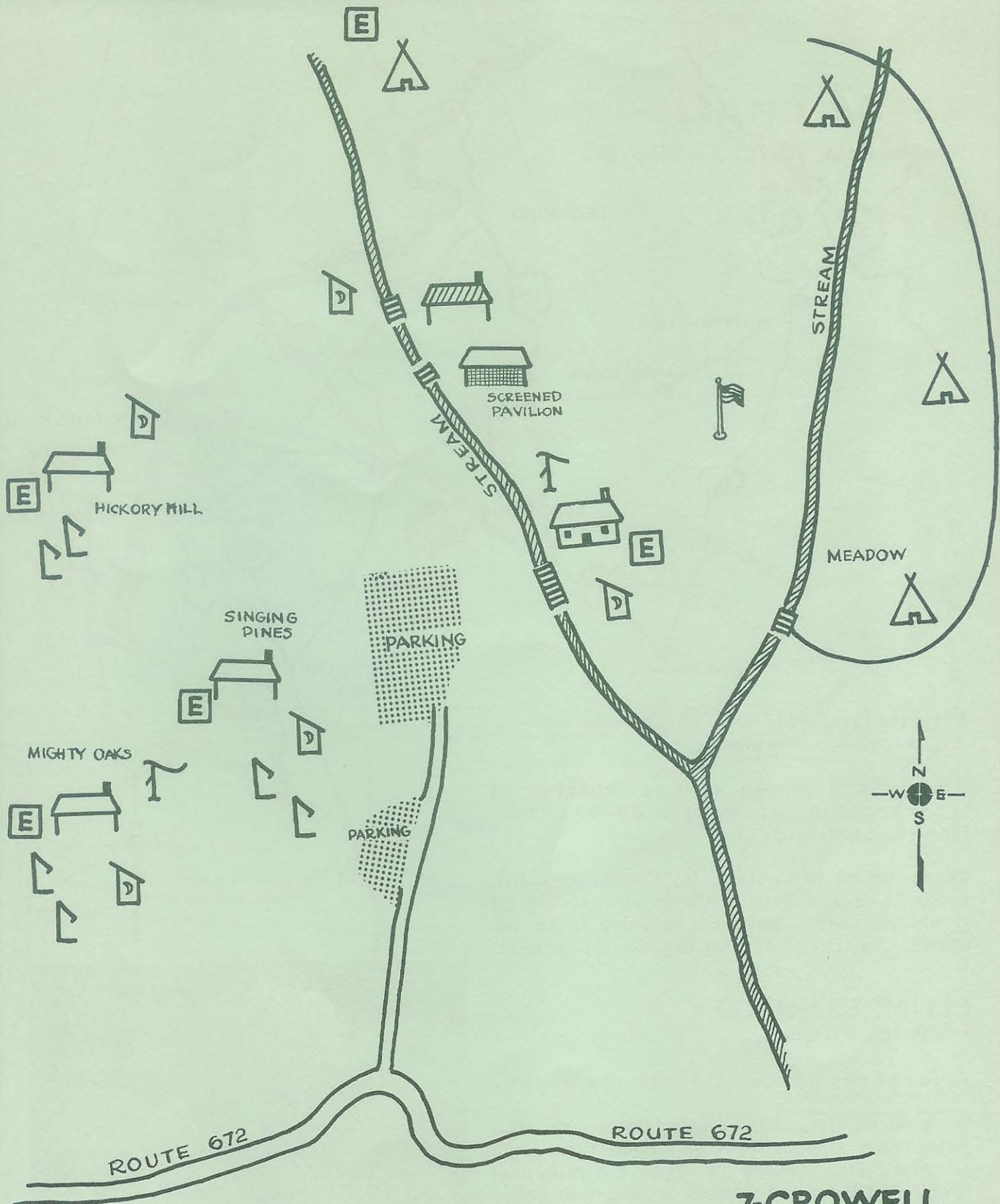




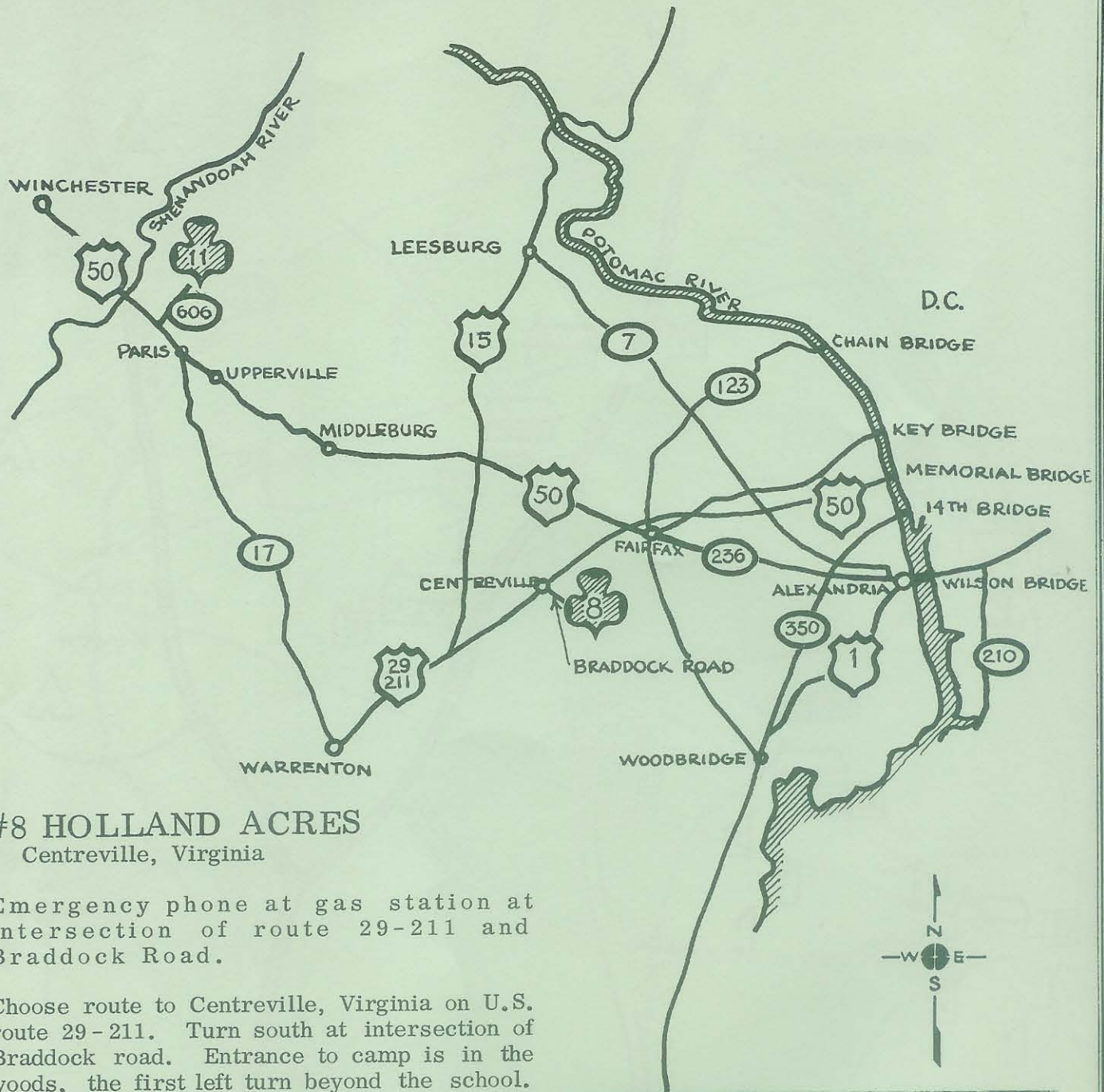
**#7 CROWELL**  
Oakton, Virginia

Emergency phone in Oakton at intersection of routes 123-674.

Go to Oakton via route 123. Turn west on route 674. Proceed 1.5 miles to route 672 (Vale Road) take it 1.2 miles to camp on right. Entrance to camp is difficult to find so check 1.2 miles carefully on mileage indicator.

## #8 HOLLAND ACRES

Centreville, Virginia

Emergency phone at gas station at intersection of route 29-211 and Braddock Road.

Choose route to Centreville, Virginia on U.S. route 29-211. Turn south at intersection of Braddock road. Entrance to camp is in the woods, the first left turn beyond the school.

## #11 MOSS RIDGE

Paris, Virginia

Emergency phone at Rodger's Diner.

Go west on U.S. 50 through Middleburg. 6.5 miles past Upperville post office turn right on route 606, which is about 1/4 mile past Rodger's Diner, and marked by Mountain Lakes Motel sign. Follow 606 for 2.1 miles and turn right on camp road.

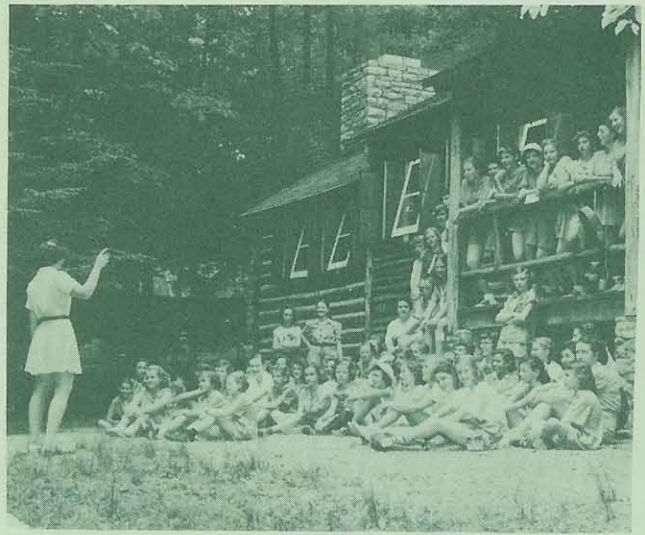
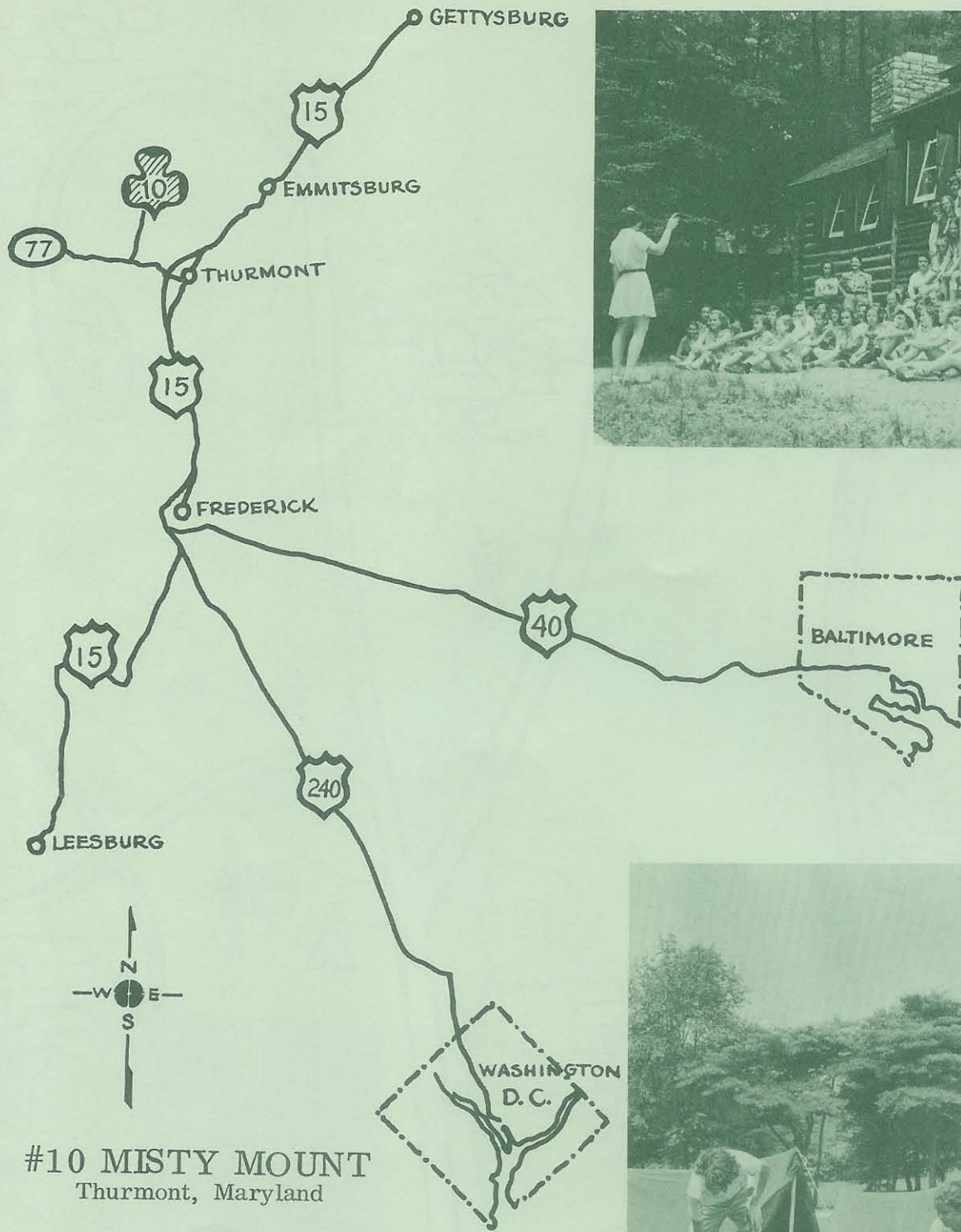
Mt. Solon, Virginia

Emergency phone at Snooks' store in Mt. Solon.

Proceed to Harrisonburg, Virginia. Watch for Rocco Feed sign and turn at next right (North Gay Street). Go two blocks and turn left on route 42. Take 42 through Dayton and Bridgewater (watch for Natural Chimney signs and follow them). Take right fork at route 747 to Mt. Solon. Turn right at Mt. Solon on route 731 (stop sign). Go 7 miles. Turn left at gas station beyond Natural Chimneys, and go 6 miles further to camp entrance.

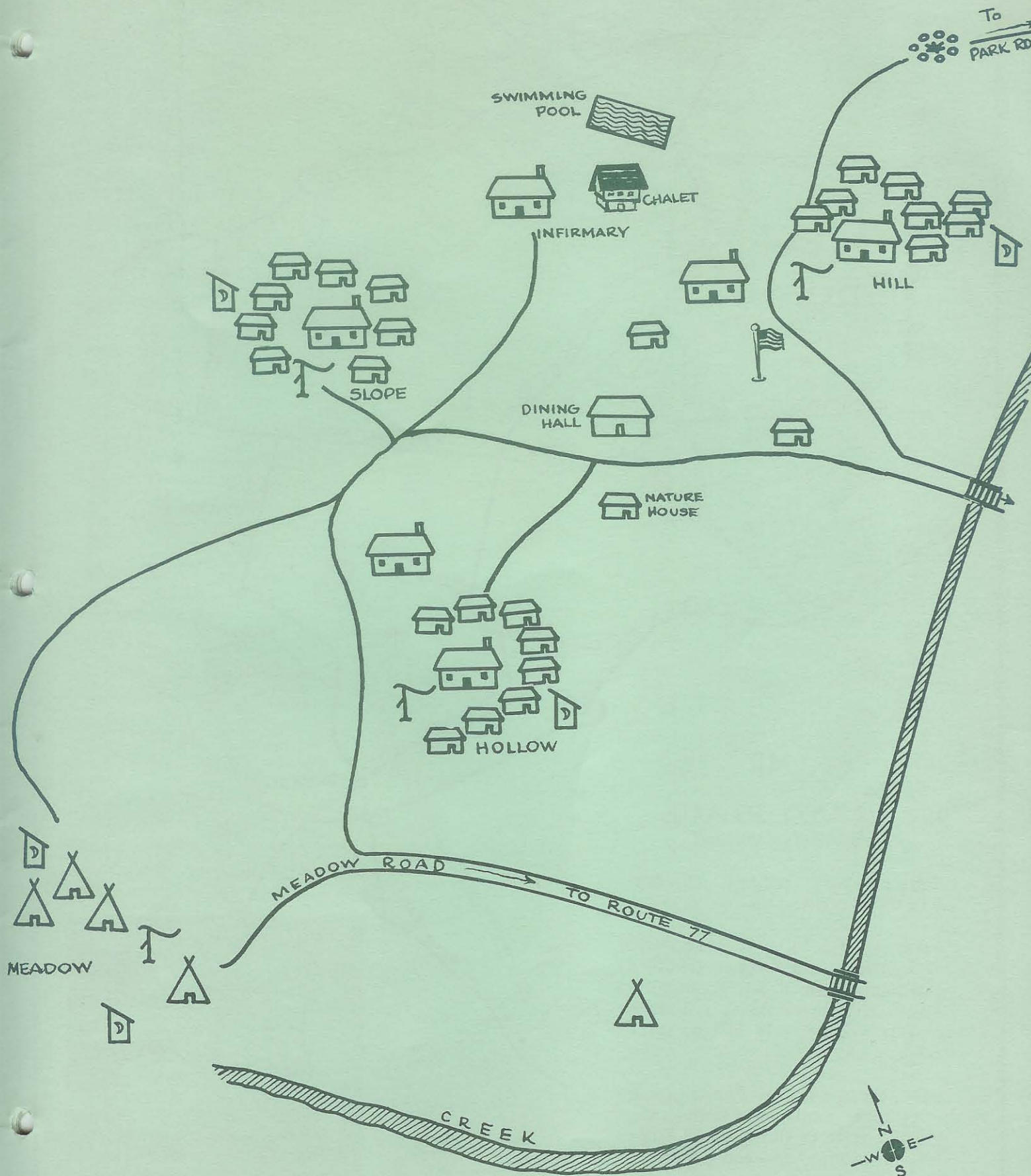
## #10 MISTY MOUNT

Emergency phone at park manager's office.

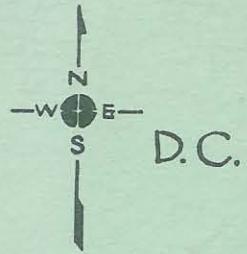
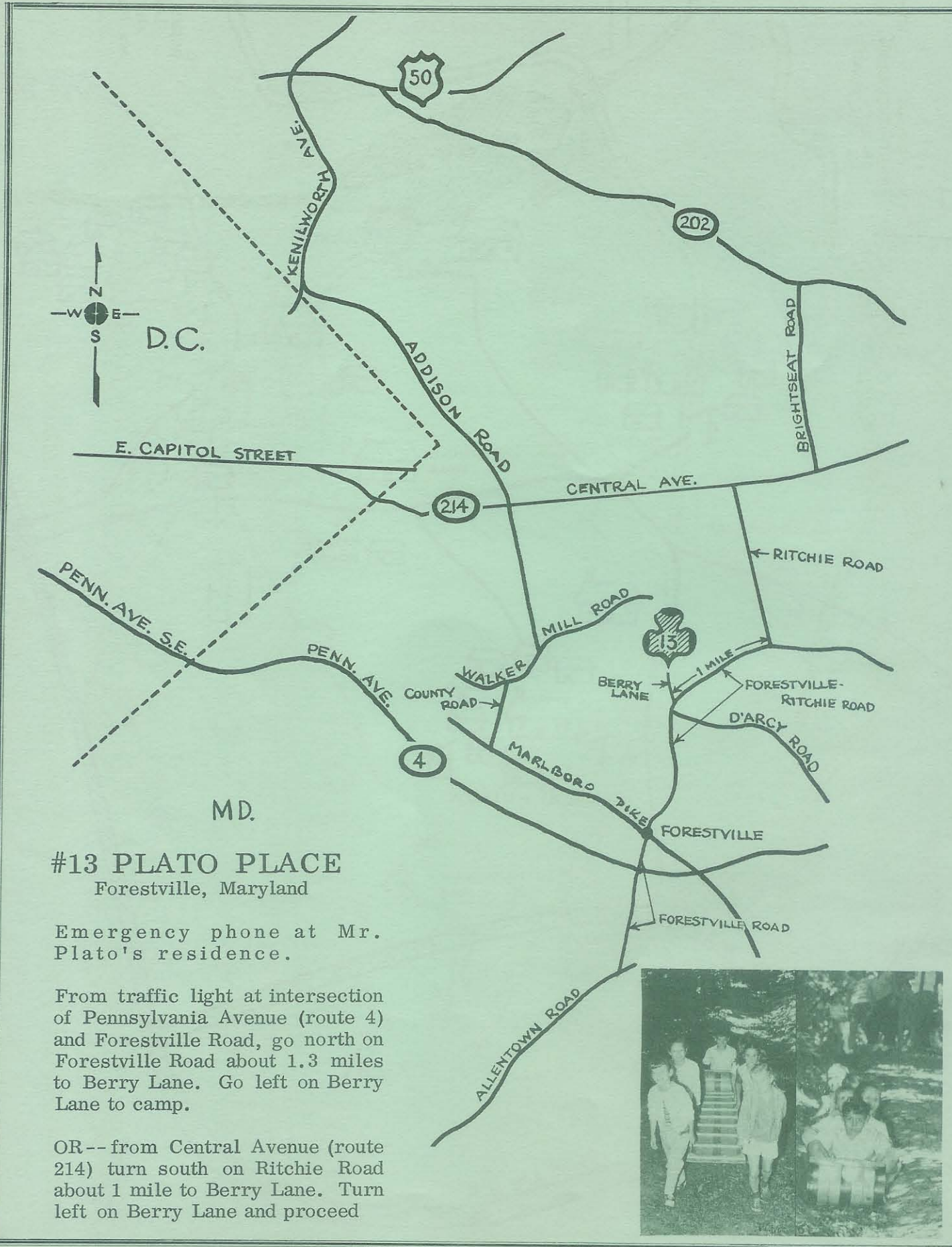

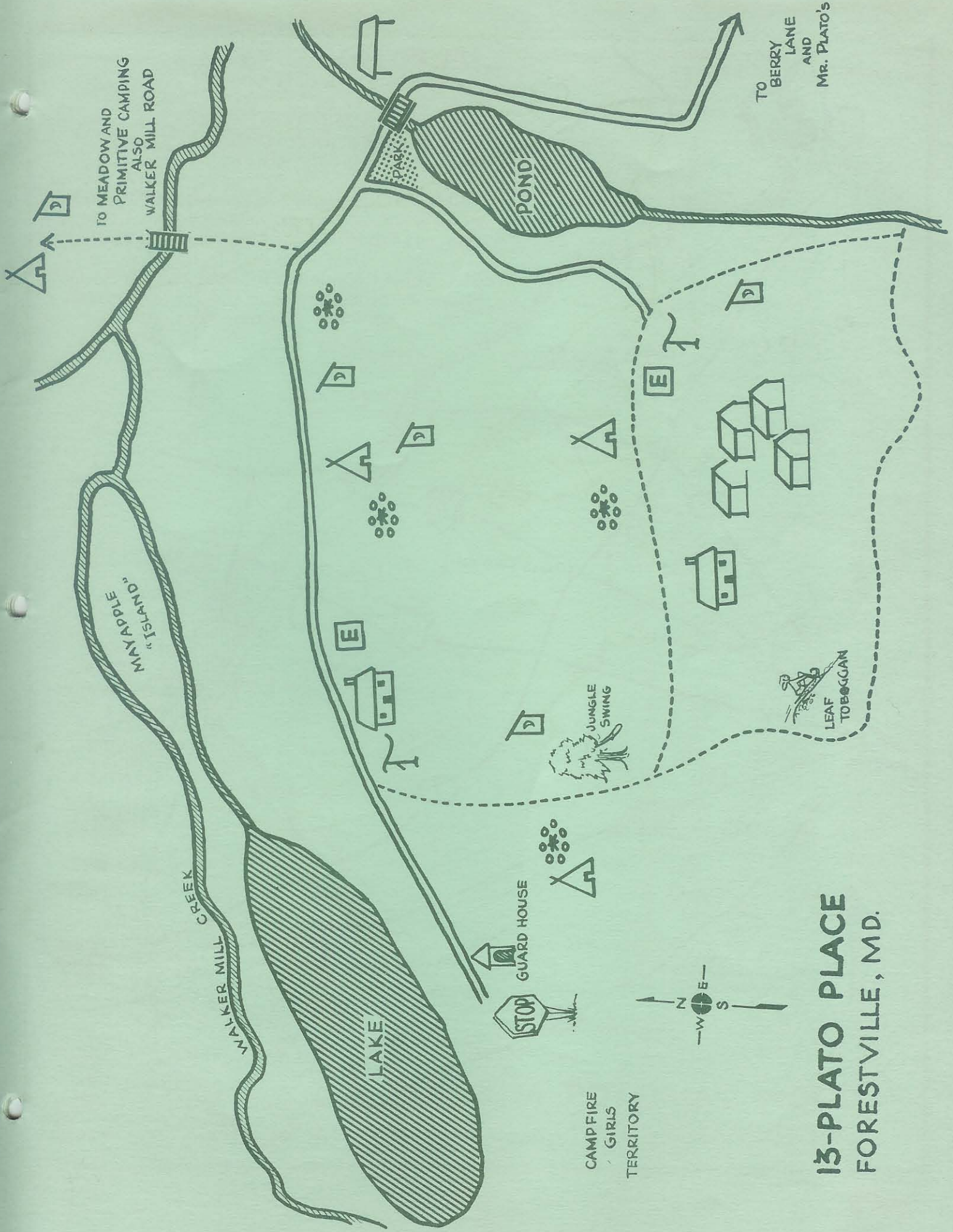
**#13 PLATO PLACE**

Emergency phone at Mr. Plato's residence.

From traffic light at intersection of Pennsylvania Avenue (route 4) and Forestville Road, go north on Forestville Road about 1.3 miles to Berry Lane. Go left on Berry Lane to camp.

OR-- from Central Avenue (route 214) turn south on Ritchie Road about 1 mile to Berry Lane. Turn left on Berry Lane and proceed

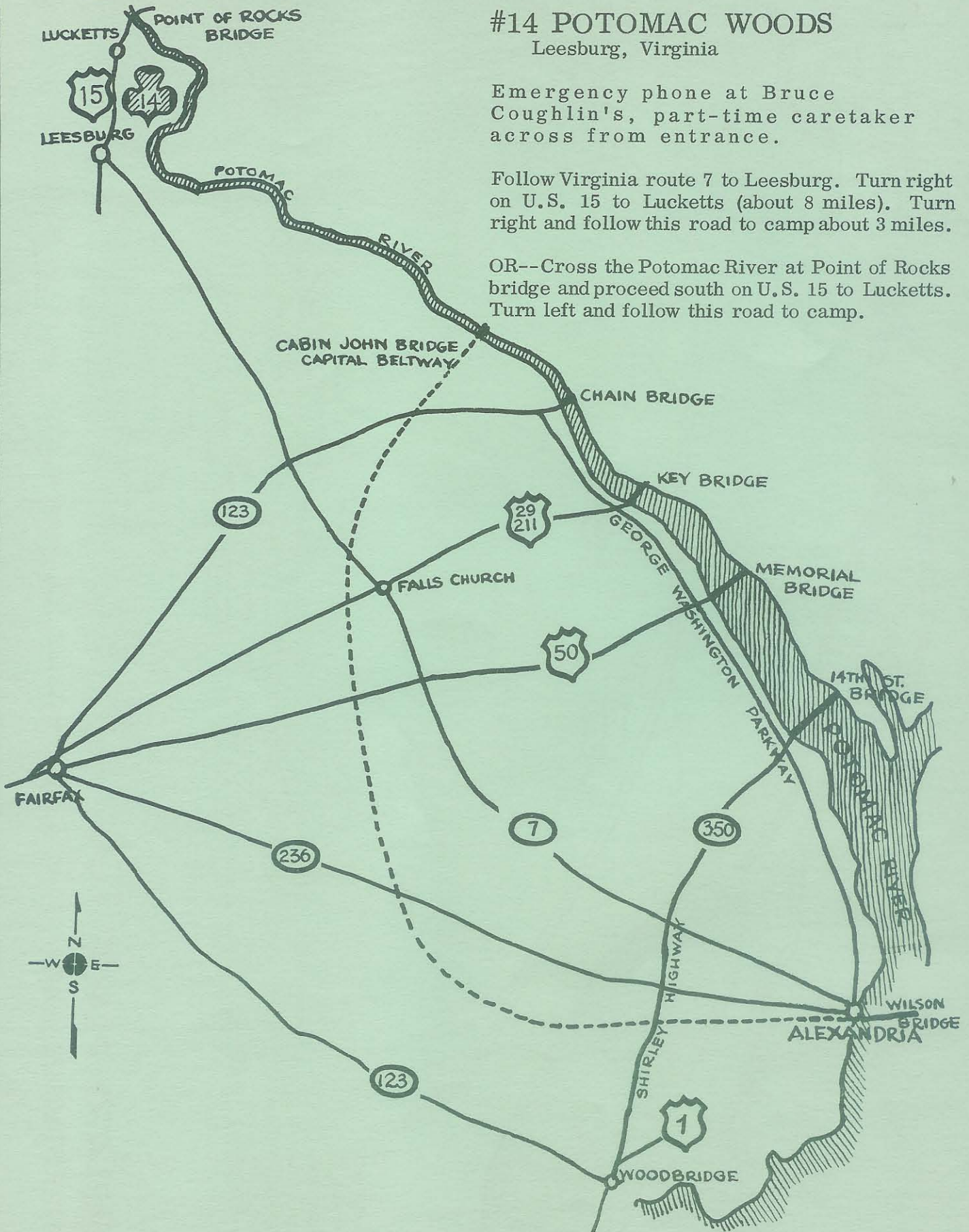
# #14 POTOMAC WOODS

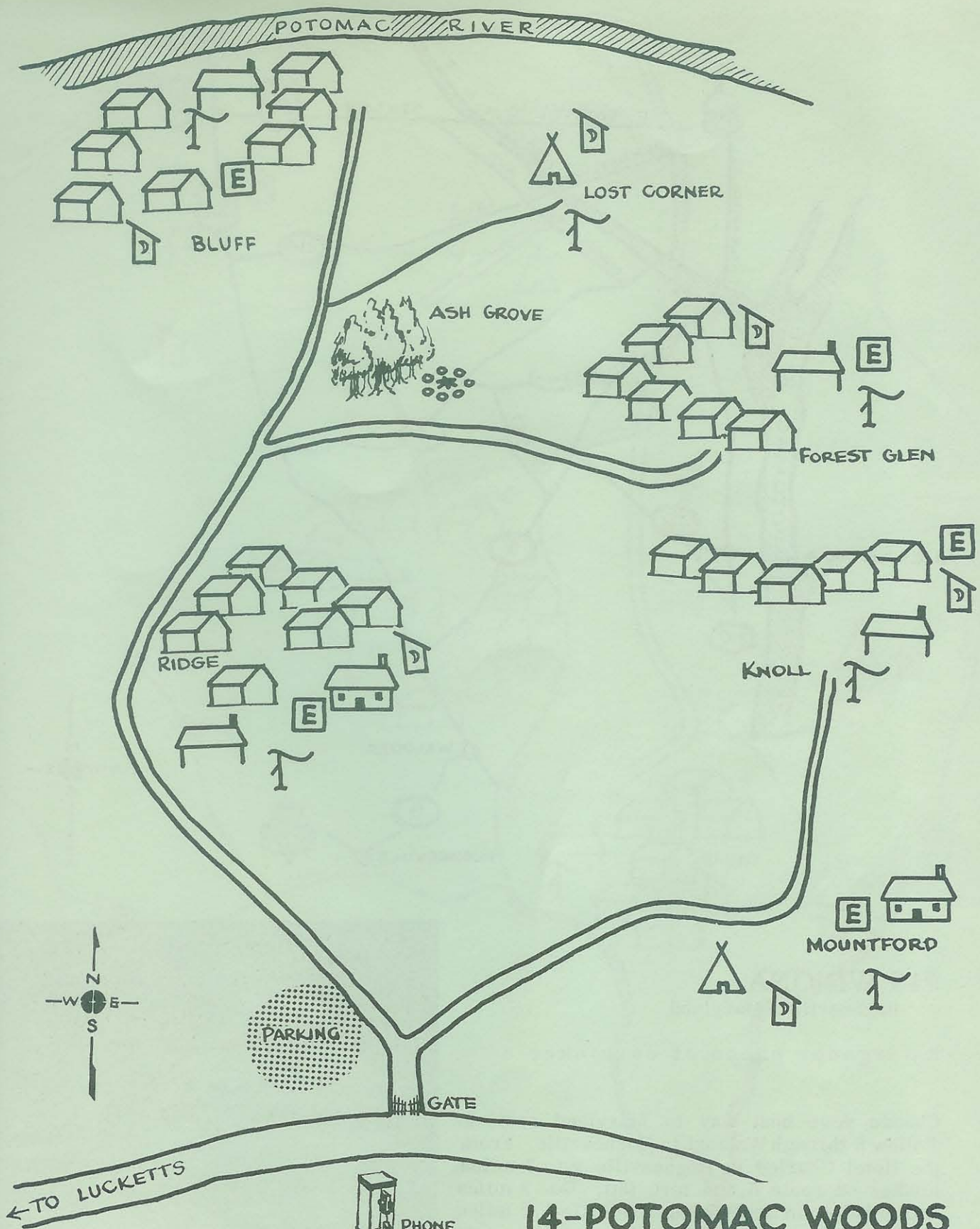
Leesburg, Virginia

Emergency phone at Bruce Coughlin's, part-time caretaker across from entrance.

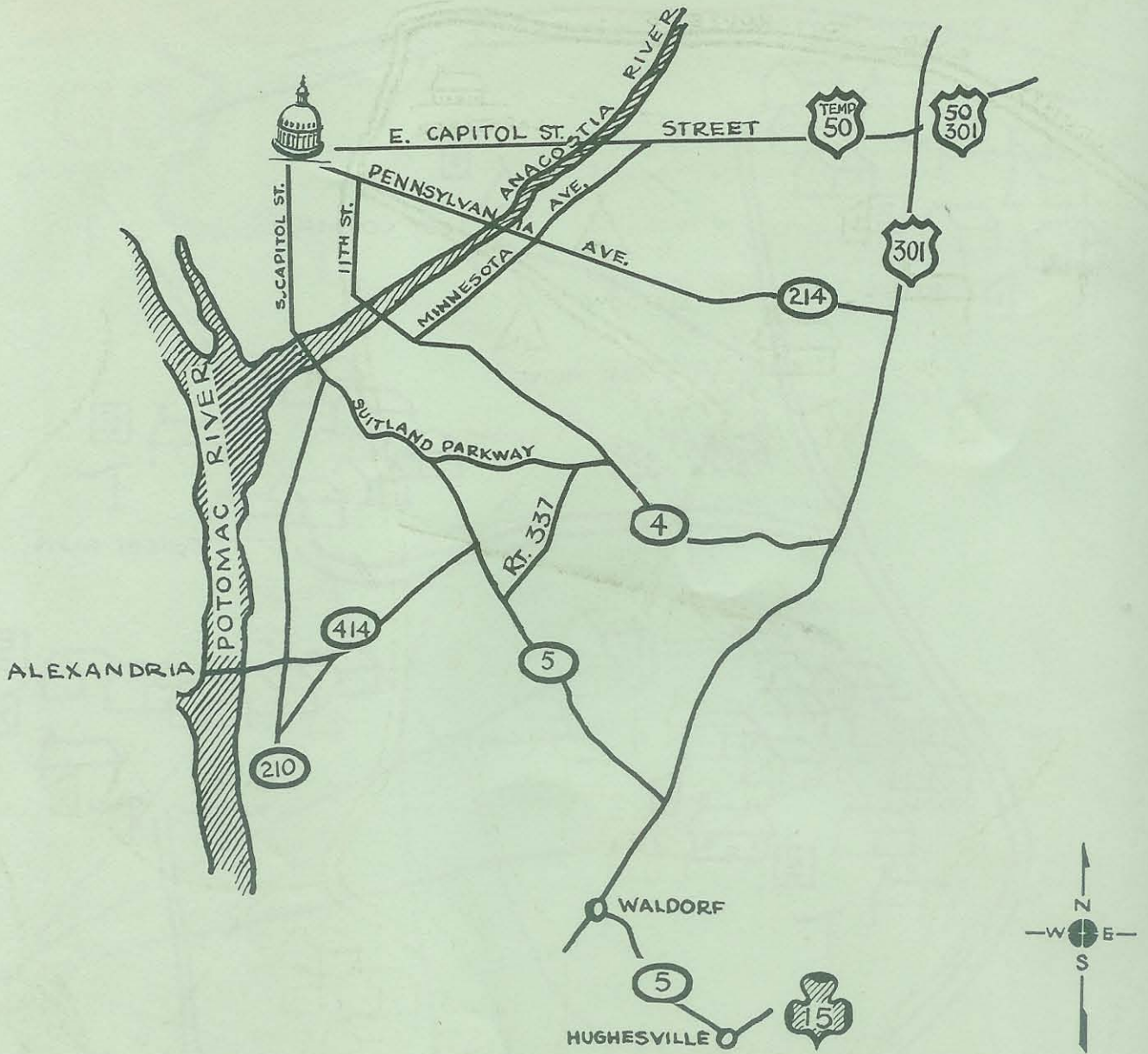
Follow Virginia route 7 to Leesburg. Turn right on U.S. 15 to Lucketts (about 8 miles). Turn right and follow this road to camp about 3 miles.

OR--Cross the Potomac River at Point of Rocks bridge and proceed south on U.S. 15 to Lucketts. Turn left and follow this road to camp.

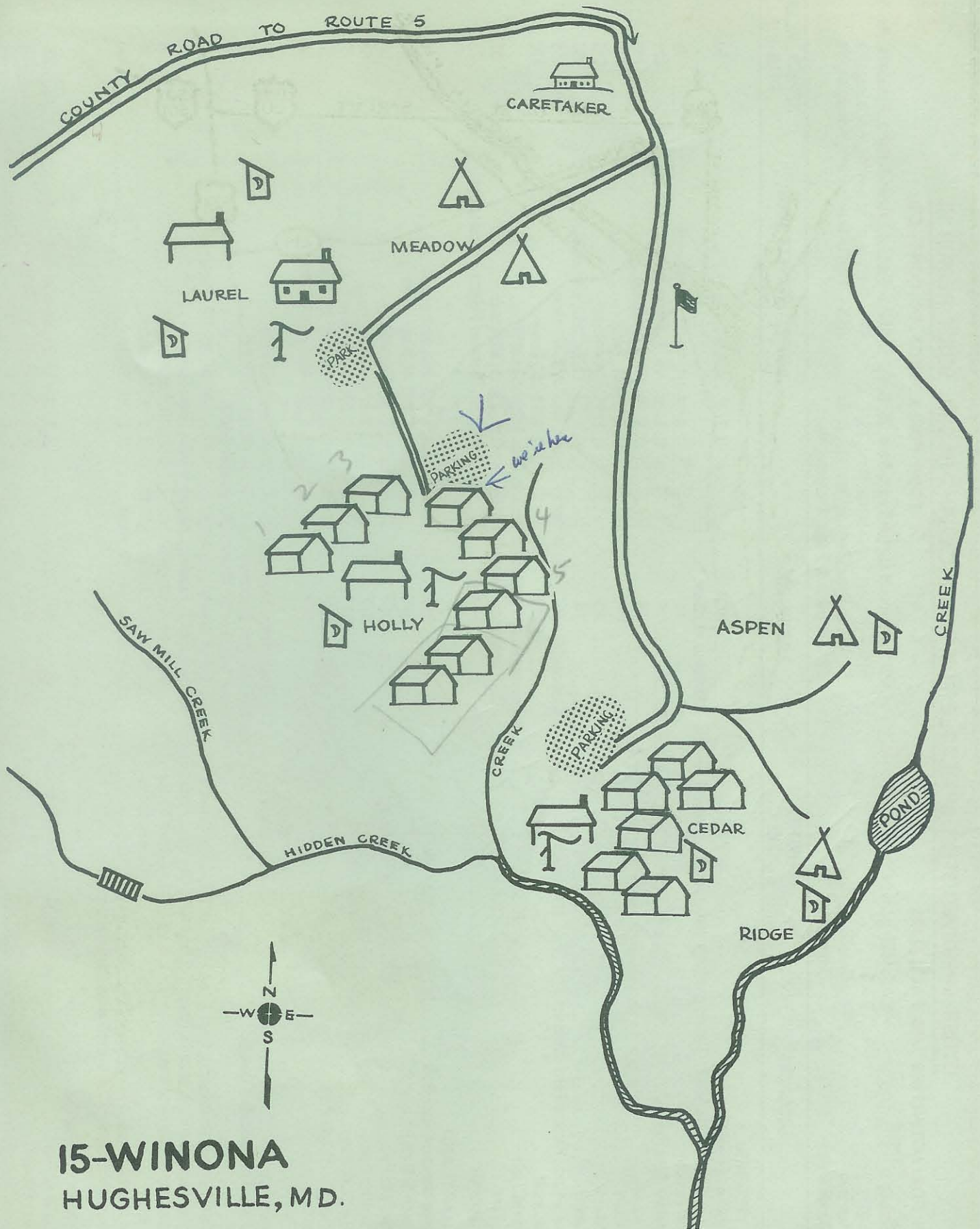
## #15 WINONA

Hughesville, Maryland

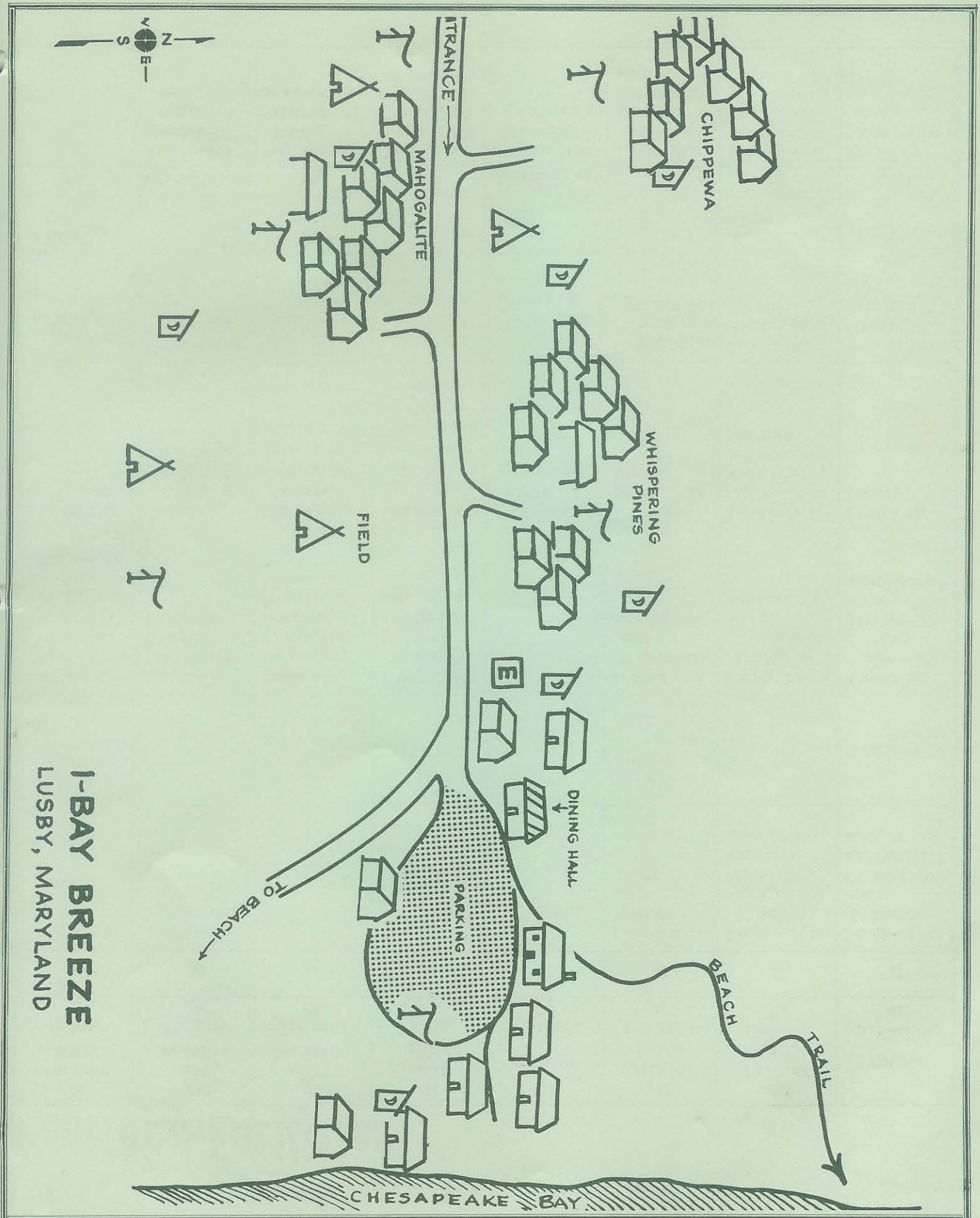
Emergency phone at caretaker's .

Choose your best way to Maryland route 5. Follow 5 through Waldorf to Hughesville. From the Hotel Charles in Hughesville go .7 miles further on route 5 and turn left. Go .2 miles and turn left on Scout Camp road. Go 1.2 miles to camp sign and caretaker's house on the right side of the road, turn right into camp.

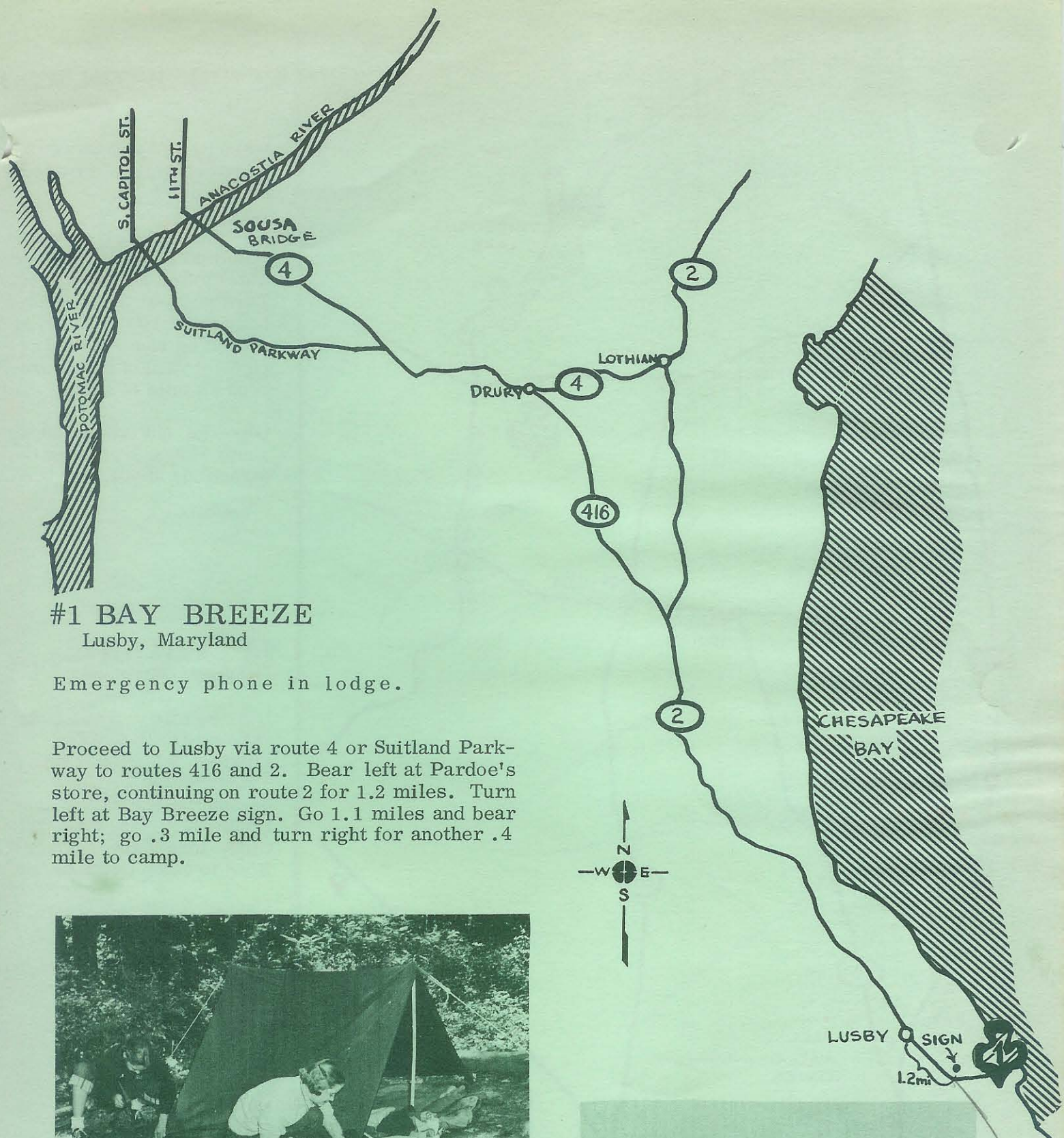

# #1 BAY BREEZE

Emergency phone in lodge.

Proceed to Lusby via route 4 or Suitland Parkway to routes 416 and 2. Bear left at Pardoe's store, continuing on route 2 for 1.2 miles. Turn left at Bay Breeze sign. Go 1.1 miles and bear right; go .3 mile and turn right for another .4 mile to camp.

## #2 BRIGHTON WOODS

Brookeville, Maryland

Emergency phone at junction of routes 650 and 108.

Go out Georgia Avenue (route 97). Bear right at water tower onto route 182. Turn right at Sandy Spring onto route 108, and left at Ashton on route 650. Turn right at Brighton and proceed .9 mile to camp.

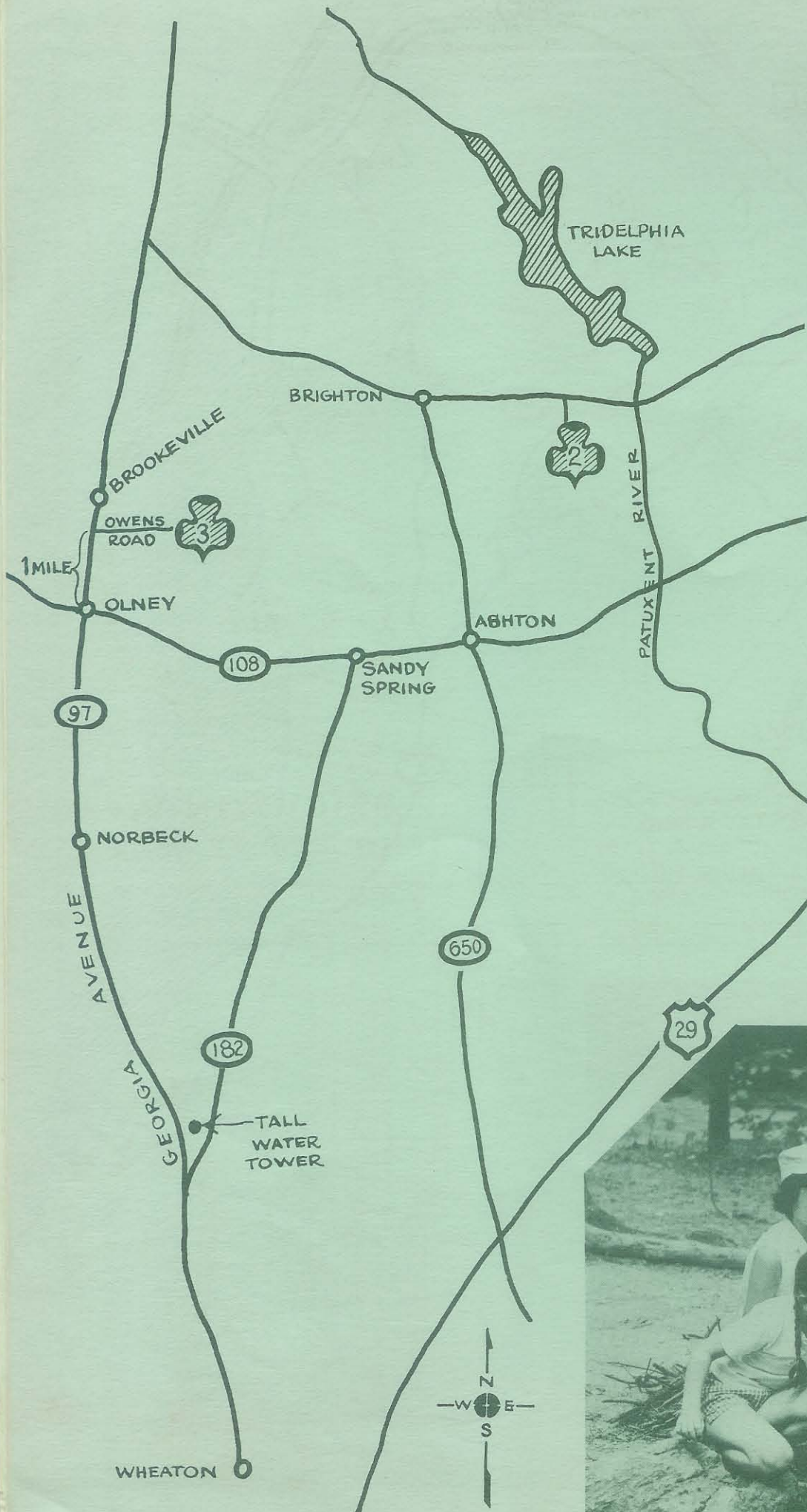
OR---go out route 29 to route 650 and proceed as directions above.

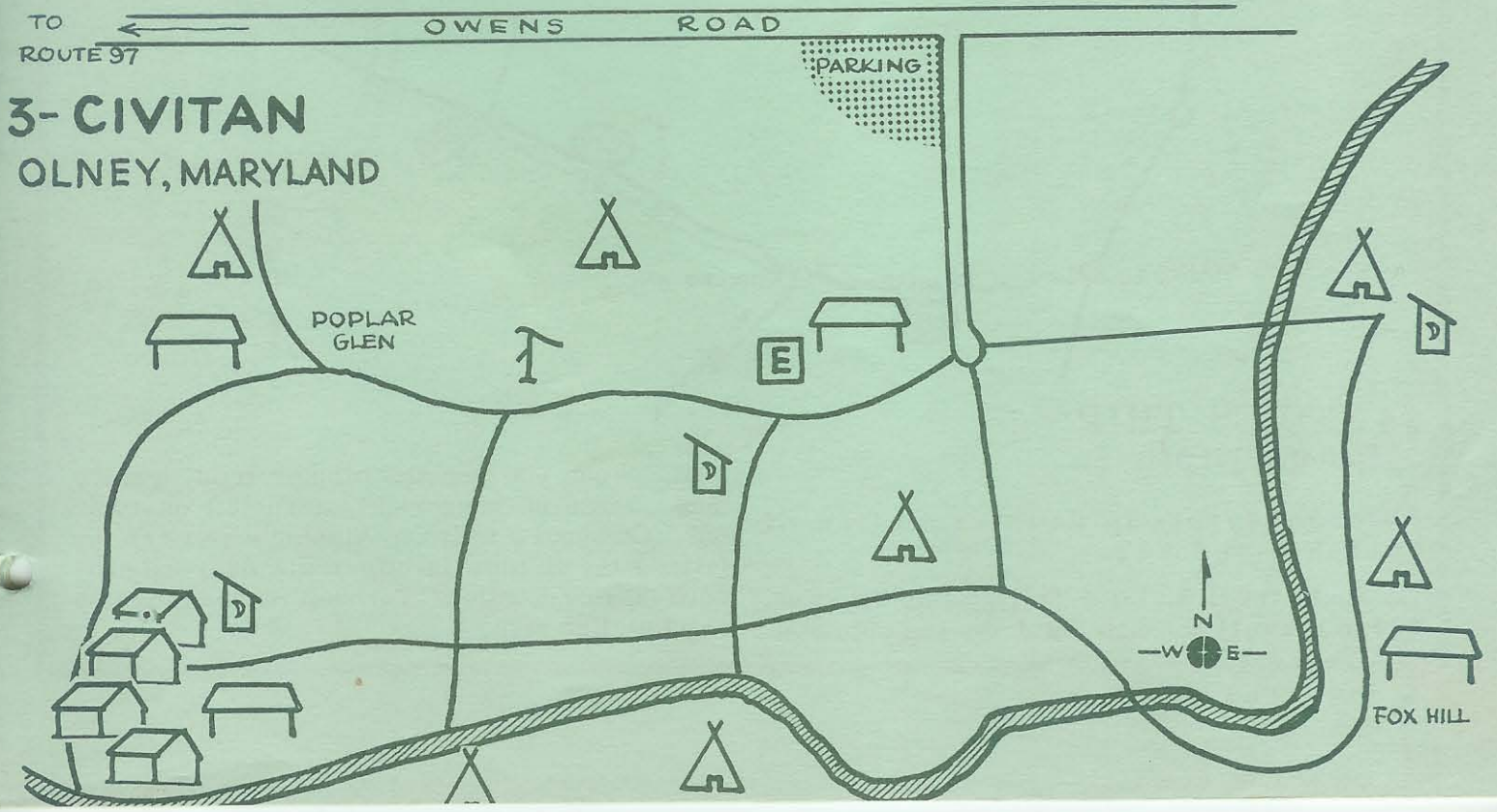
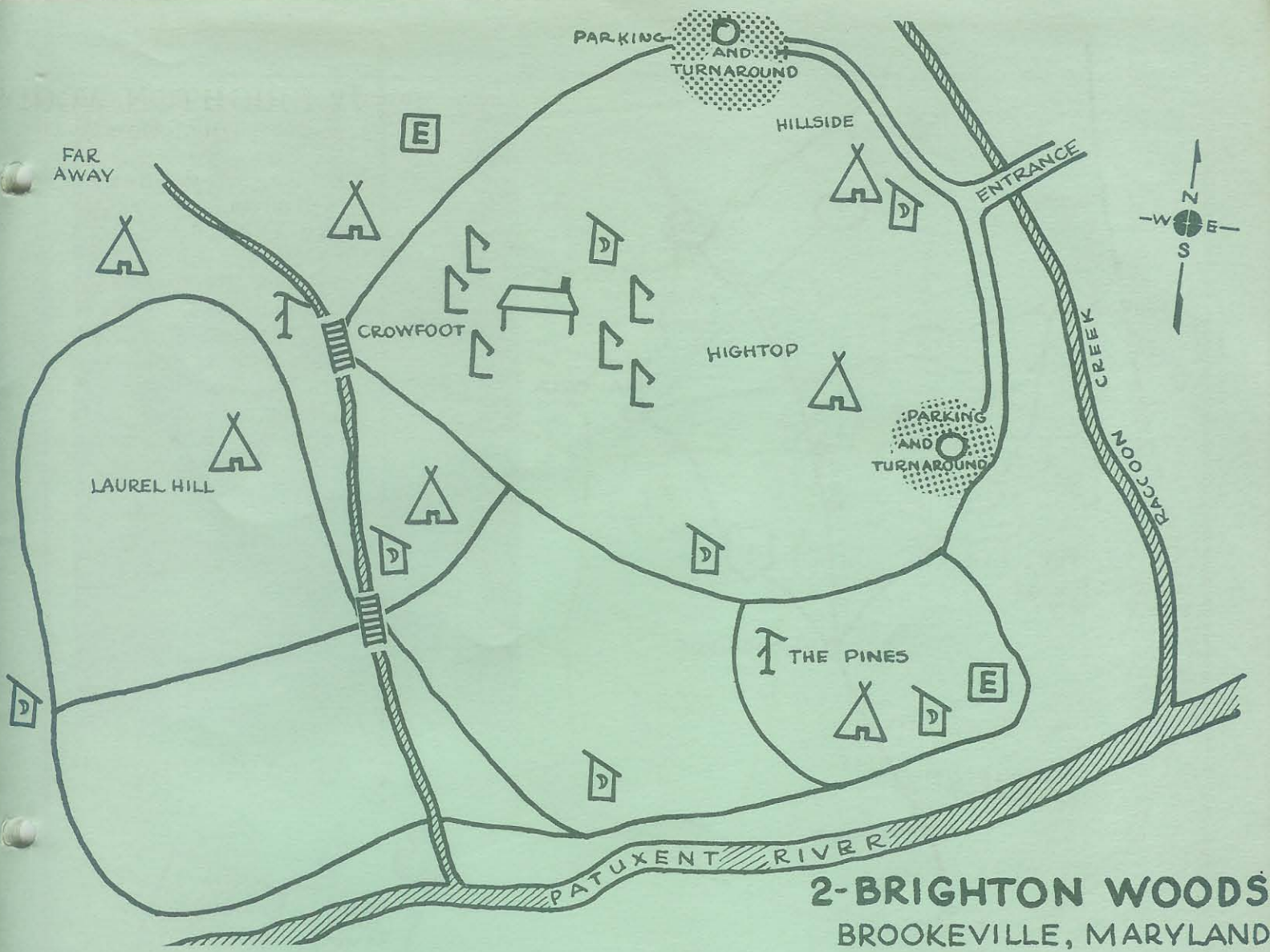
## #3 CIVITAN

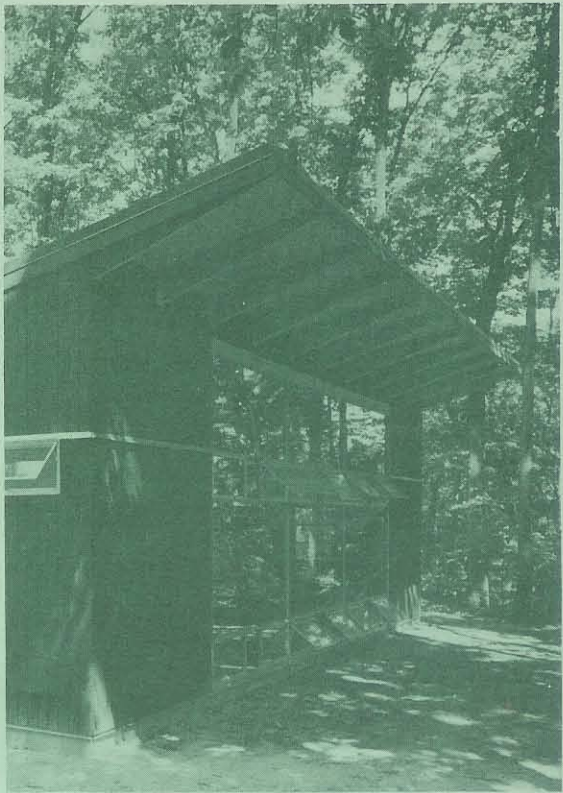
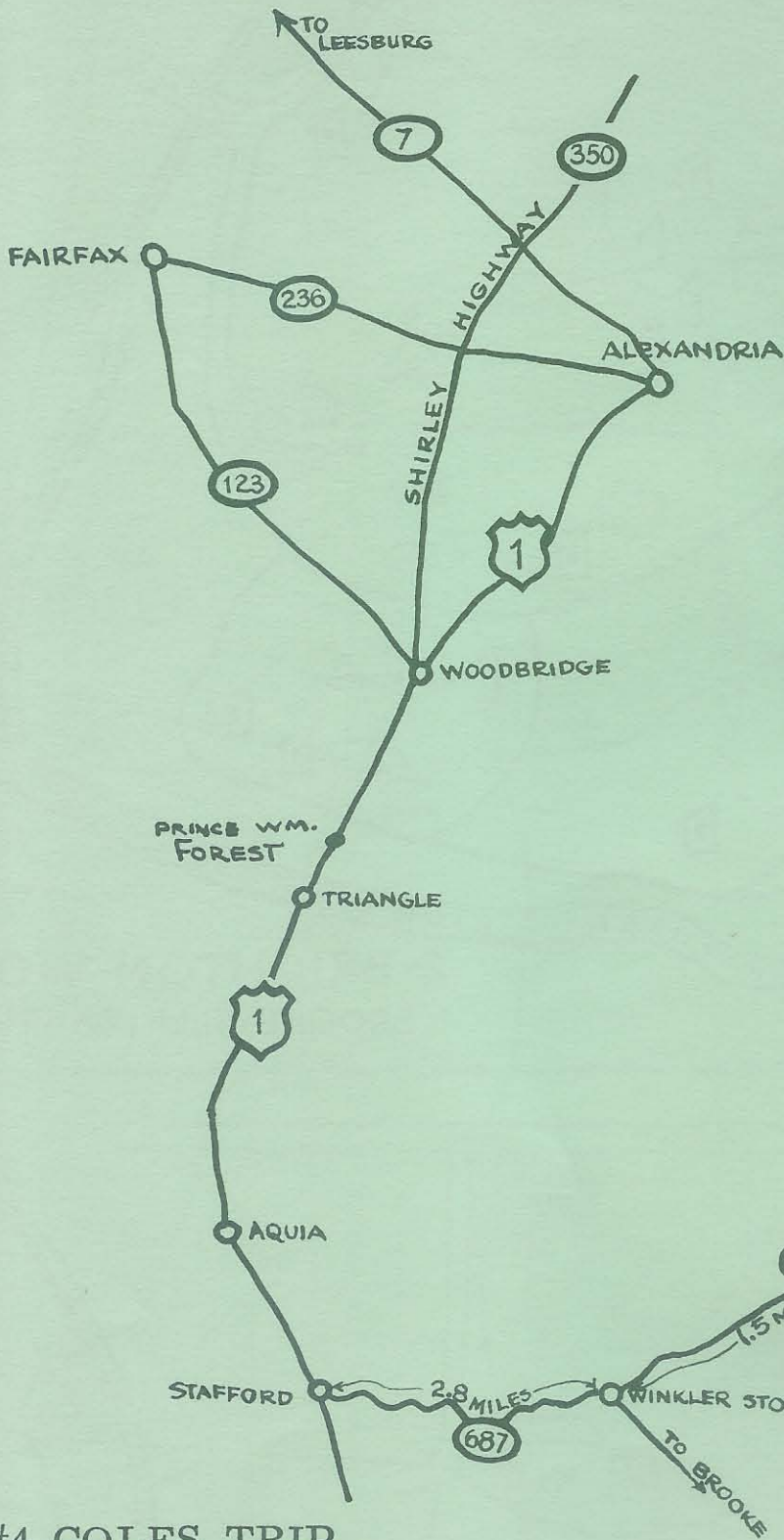
Olney, Maryland

Stafford, Virginia

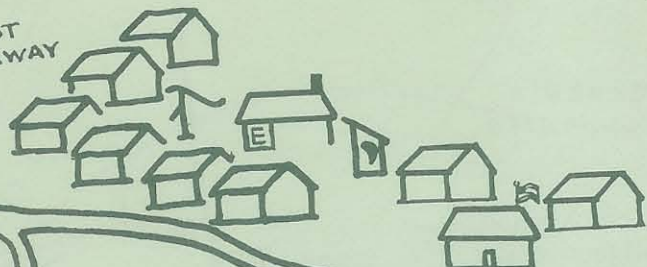
Emergency phone at intersection of routes 1 and 687.

Go south On U.S. 1 (or Shirley Highway—route 350 to route 1) through Dumfries and into Staf-

ford. When you see the blinker light, and the court house on your right, turn left on route 687. Go about 3 miles to Winkler's store on the left. Pass it (this is now route 629) and proceed about 1.5 miles. Turn left on road to camp at white fish sign.
